2. Fees & Payment Terms

Non-Refundable Deposit: \$450.00 due with this signed contract.

Balance Due: Remaining balance is due when the mare is 45 days in foal.

Deadlines & Restrictions: * All monies must be paid by December 1st of the calendar year bred.

- o If fees are unpaid by Dec 1, 2026, a stallion service report will not be filed, and the foal will be un-registerable.
- o The stallion owner's service certificate portion of the registration application will only be signed once all balances are paid in full.

3. Breeding Options & Care Fees

Live Cover / On-Site Care

Mare Care Rate: \$5.00 per day.

Mare & Foal Care Rate: \$7.00 per day.

Artificial Insemination (AI)

Important Note: AI is only available for TruWest Silver Suede using frozen semen (60% post-thaw motility).

AI Fee: \$375.00 paid directly to The Oklahoma Equine Clinic.

Inclusions: This fee covers the shipment of two (2) doses of frozen semen and includes the return postage for the frozen shipping container.

Process: Once the breeding fee and AI fees are settled, the stallion owner will coordinate shipment with the clinic to your veterinarian. (Clinic Contact: Caity Hood at 405-642-8507).

4. Mare Owner Obligations

Cycle Limits: The mare will not be served through more than four (4) estrous cycles during the breeding season.

Health Status: If the mare does not conceive after the first two heat cycles, she must be cultured. Proof of a negative infection culture must be provided to the stallion owner before further semen shipments are sent.

Barren/Loss Notification: If the mare proves barren or the foal dies at birth, notice signed by a licensed veterinarian must be sent to the stallion owner within 10 days of the determination.

5. Stallion Owner Guarantees & Terms

Live Foal Guarantee: The breeding fee guarantees a live standing foal (defined as a foal that successfully stands and nurses).

Exclusions: Should the foal die due to injury or neglect, the stallion owner is under no further obligation. A veterinarian report is strictly required to determine the cause of death before any replacement semen is shipped.

Interruption of Service: If the stallion dies or in any way becomes unfit for service, or if the mare dies before being served (and no substitute mare is mutually agreed upon), this contract becomes null and void. The deposit will be refunded, less any costs for transport incurred, collection, or reasonable expenses.

Resolution Options: If the mare is barren or the foal dies without standing and nursing (verified by a veterinarian within 10 days), the stallion owner reserves the option to either:

1. Re-breed the mare (mare owner pays only transport and collection fees).
2. Refund of \$200.00, effectively canceling and fulfilling the contract.

6. Binding Agreement

This contract is invalid unless completed in full and signed by both parties.
